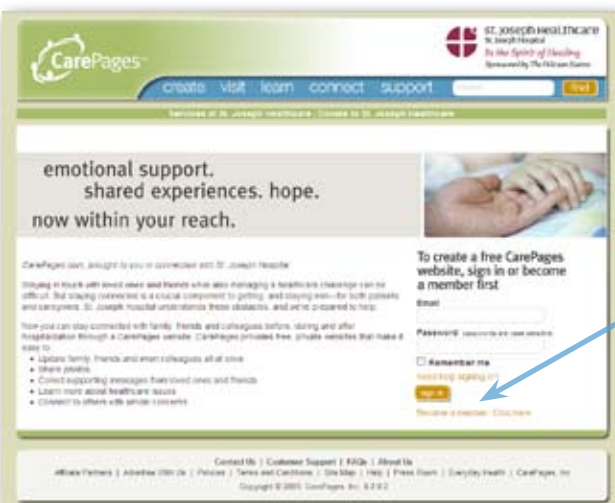
Read an introduction to St. Joseph Hospital CarePages on our CarePages web page, then click the CarePages logo to get started

On the **St. Joseph Healthcare CarePages Welcome Screen**, click the **Become a Member link**

You must become a CarePages member in order to create or view a CarePage. Membership is free. You must be age 14 or older to register.



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Fill out the online registration form

Be sure to check the box accepting Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy (If you would like to review the Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Policy first, click on the links). You can also consider un-checking the option to receive e-mails and leaving the special offer check box blank you wish.

and then click the **Sign Up button**

After you successfully complete the registration process, you will be directed to the CarePages Website where you can explore existing CarePages, or create your own.

As you Create your CarePage: A Word about Privacy

To ensure that all CarePages websites are private, each CarePages website has a unique name provided by the CarePages website Manager (the patient or family member who creates the site). CarePages website names are not available to the general public. When setting up a CarePage for the first time, the CarePages website Manager may choose from three options to control access to his or her CarePages website:

Select your privacy level:

To protect your privacy, only registered CarePages members can see your CarePages website. But you can also customize your privacy settings even more. Choose from three different levels:

Level 1:
Allow any registered user to find and view my CarePages website.
Note: To protect the privacy of children and infants on the Web, we do not offer an 'Open' privacy option for CarePages websites that are for children younger than 14 years of age.

Level 2:
Allow only invited visitors to find and view my CarePages website.

Level 3:
Allow only visitors I approve to view my CarePages website.

CarePages website name:

This name will be used to identify your CarePages website. Please do not use spaces or special characters. 40 character maximum.

- **Level 1: Open Access CarePages websites.** All CarePages members can view your CarePages website. Members who opt for an Open Access CarePages website can still maintain control over the Guestbook and can block and remove individuals at any time.
- **Level 2: Private Access CarePages websites.** Only members with whom you share your CarePages website name may view your CarePages website.
- **Level 3: Restricted Access CarePages websites.** The only way a member can visit your Restricted Access CarePages website is if you invite him or her electronically by using the Invite Visitor link on your page.

An open access CarePages website encourages messages of concern and support from the entire community of members, including other individuals who may be going through a similar health challenge. However, for those who would prefer to limit access to their CarePage to their circle of family and friends, we suggest selecting option 2 or option 3 when signing up.

If you change your mind later, you have the option to change the privacy level of your CarePages website at any time.



Once you have created your CarePage, simply repeat steps 1 and 2 to navigate to your CarePages account and enter your username and password to return and view or edit your website
